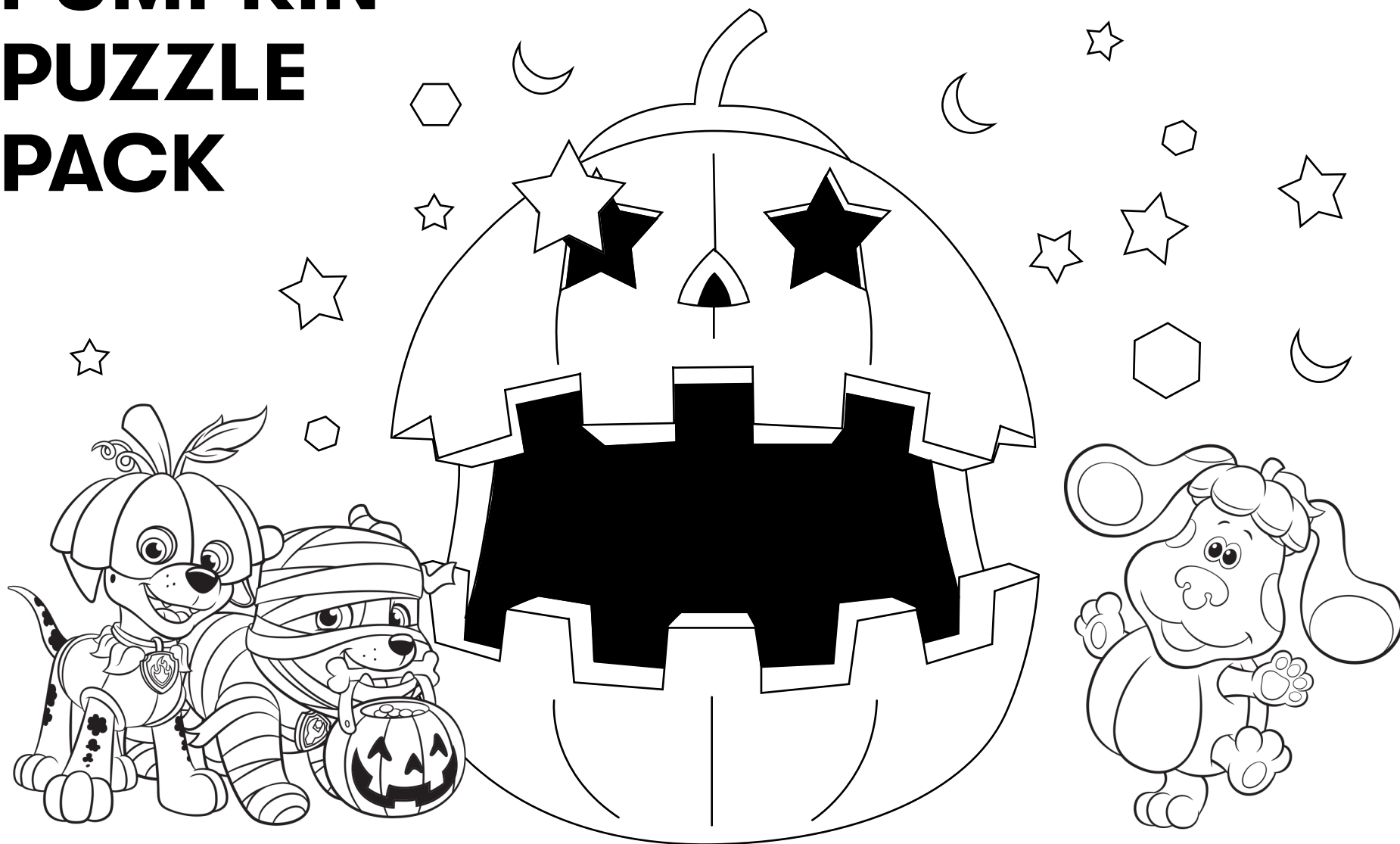
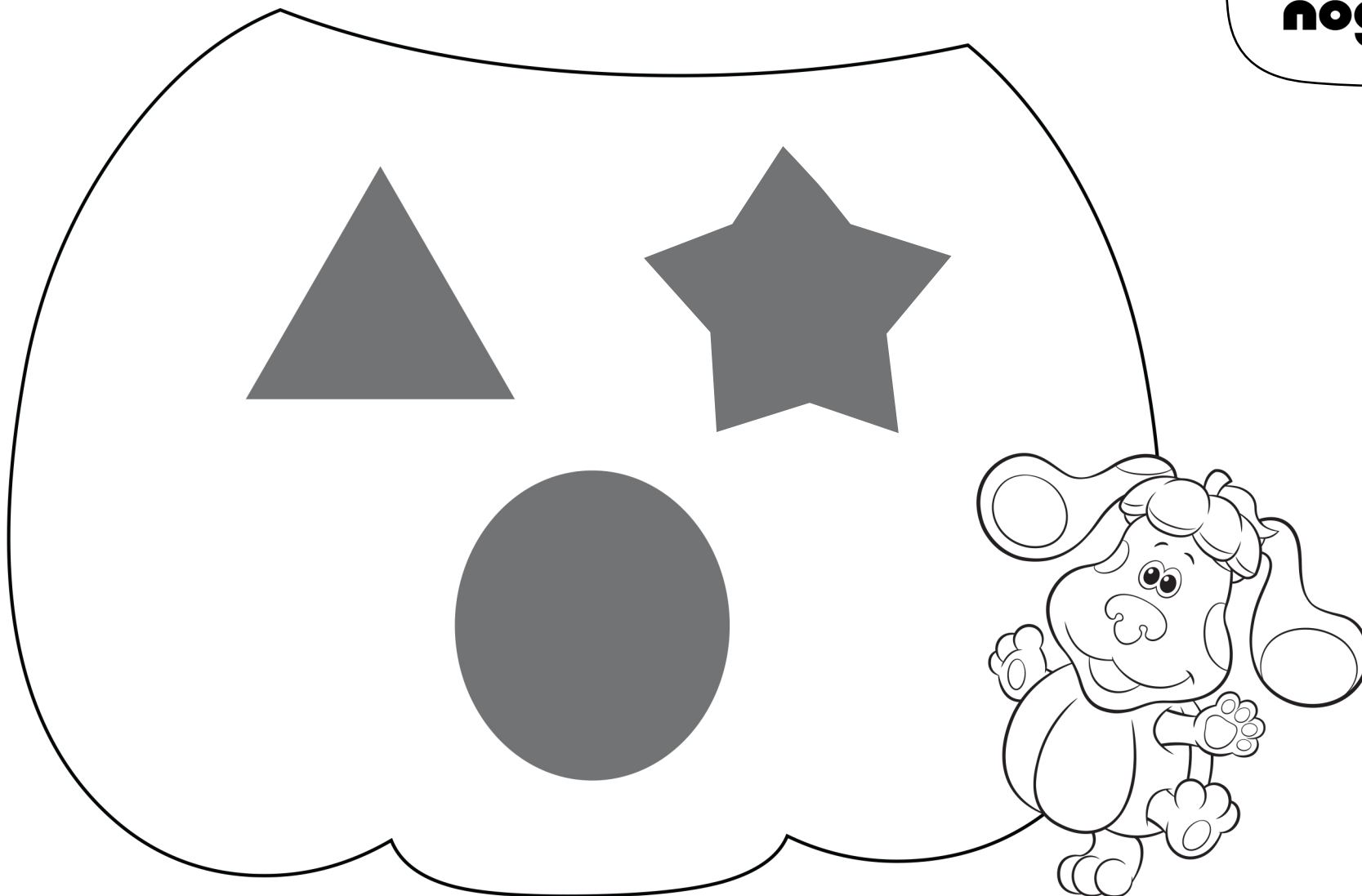


# PUMPKIN PUZZLE PACK



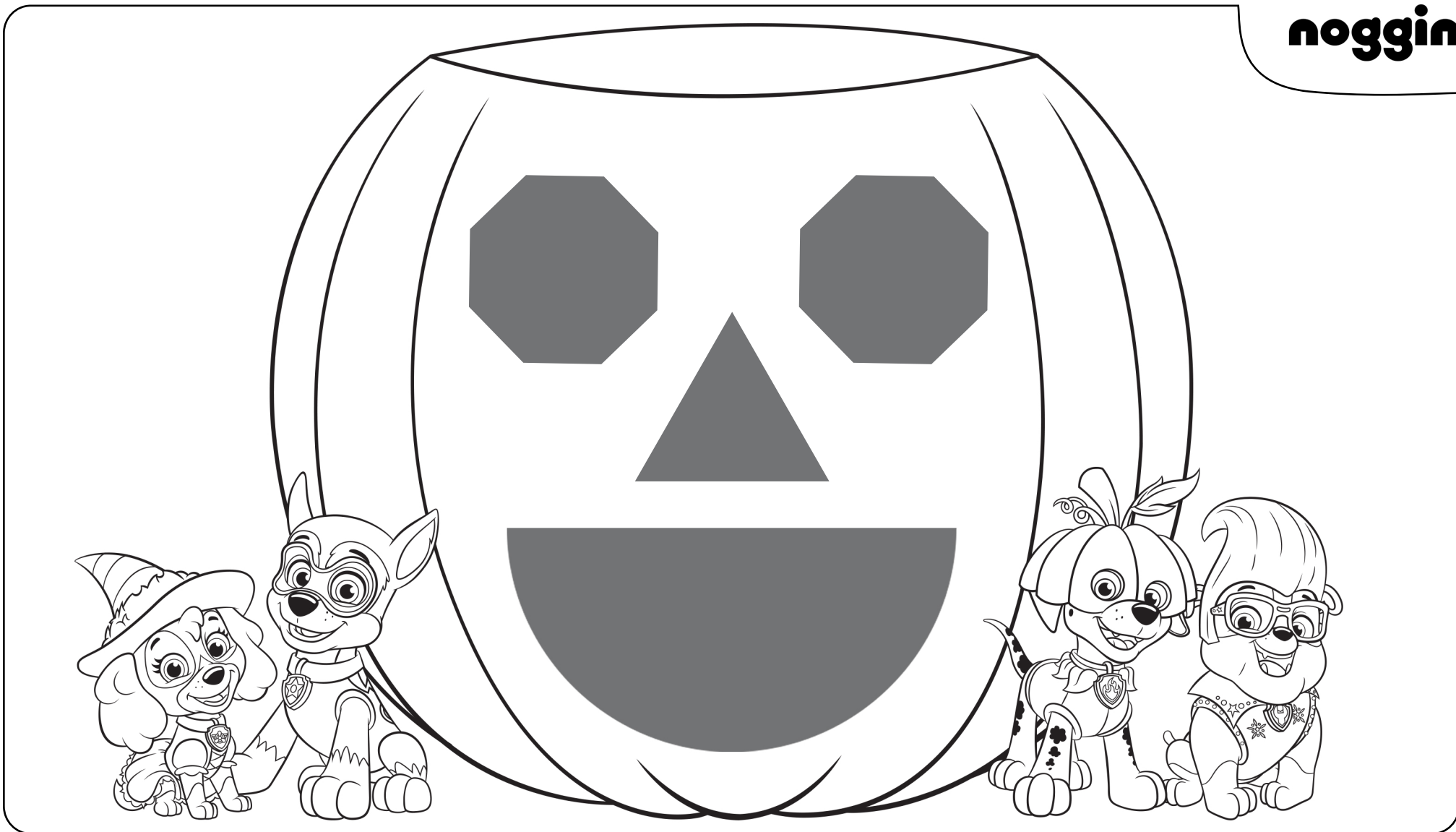


## **BLUE'S CLUES PUMPKIN PAGE**

Puzzle through this fun activity with your child! Help them color in the pumpkin, then color and cut out all the shapes on page 4 of this activity pack. Place each shape where it belongs on the pumpkin puzzle.

**Learning tip:** When you place a new piece on the pumpkin, ask your child what the name of the shape is.

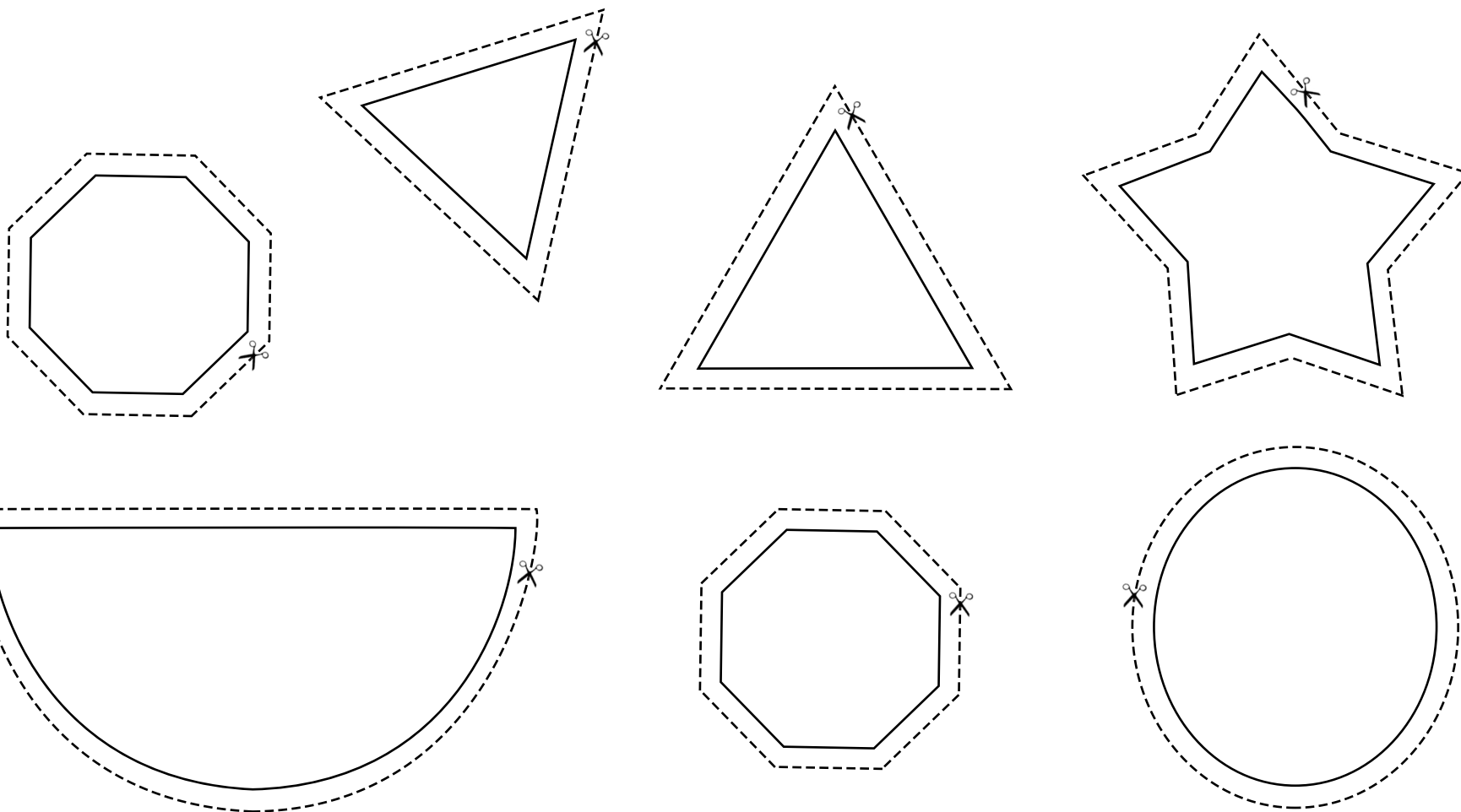




## **PAW PATROL PUMPKIN**

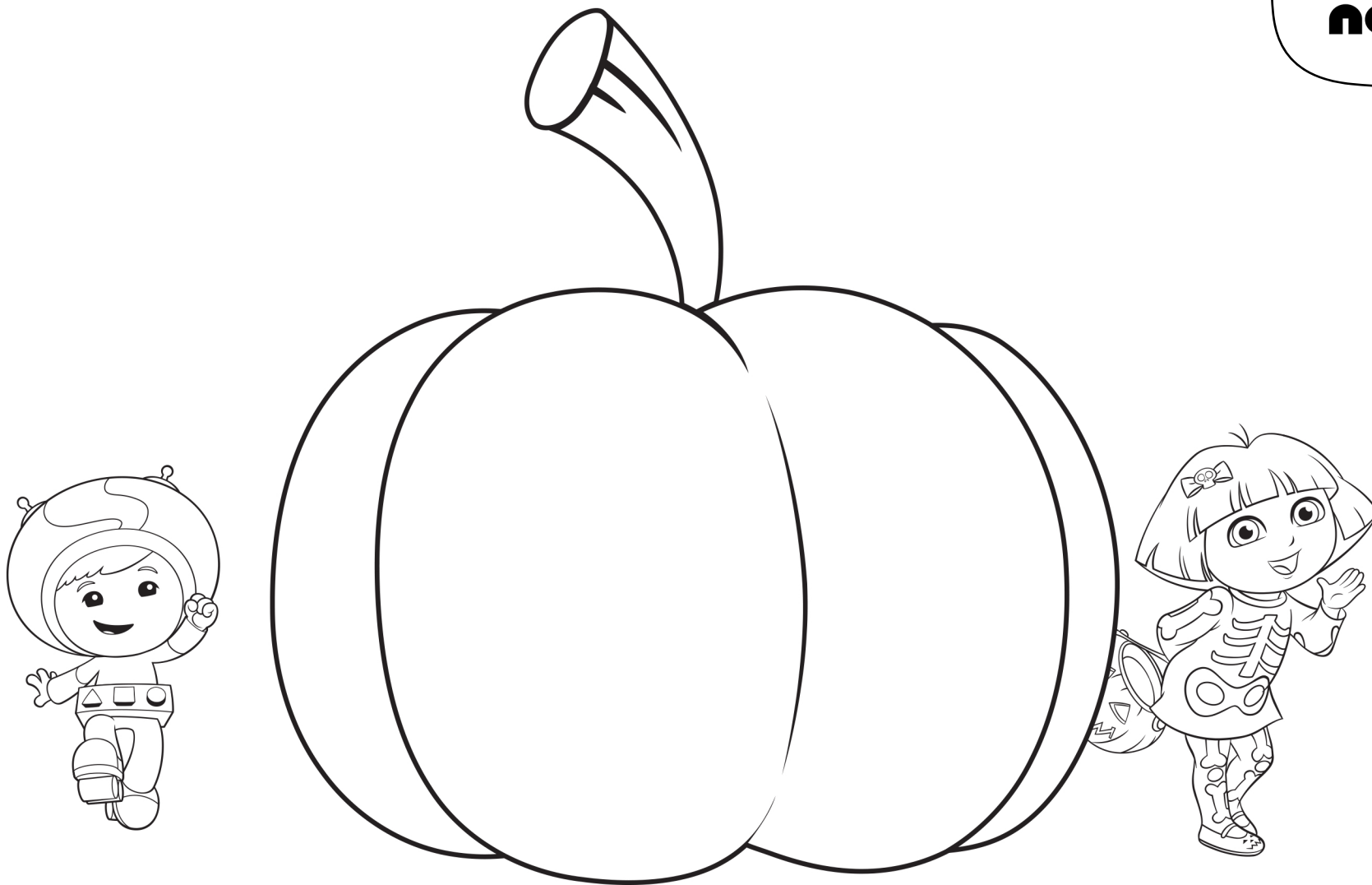
Puzzle through this fun activity with your child! Help them color in the pumpkin, then color and cut out all the shapes on page 5 of this activity pack. Place each shape where it belongs on the pumpkin puzzle.

**Learning tip:** Every time you place a new piece on the pumpkin, ask your child how many sides the shape has.



## **PUMPKIN PUZZLES - SHAPES**

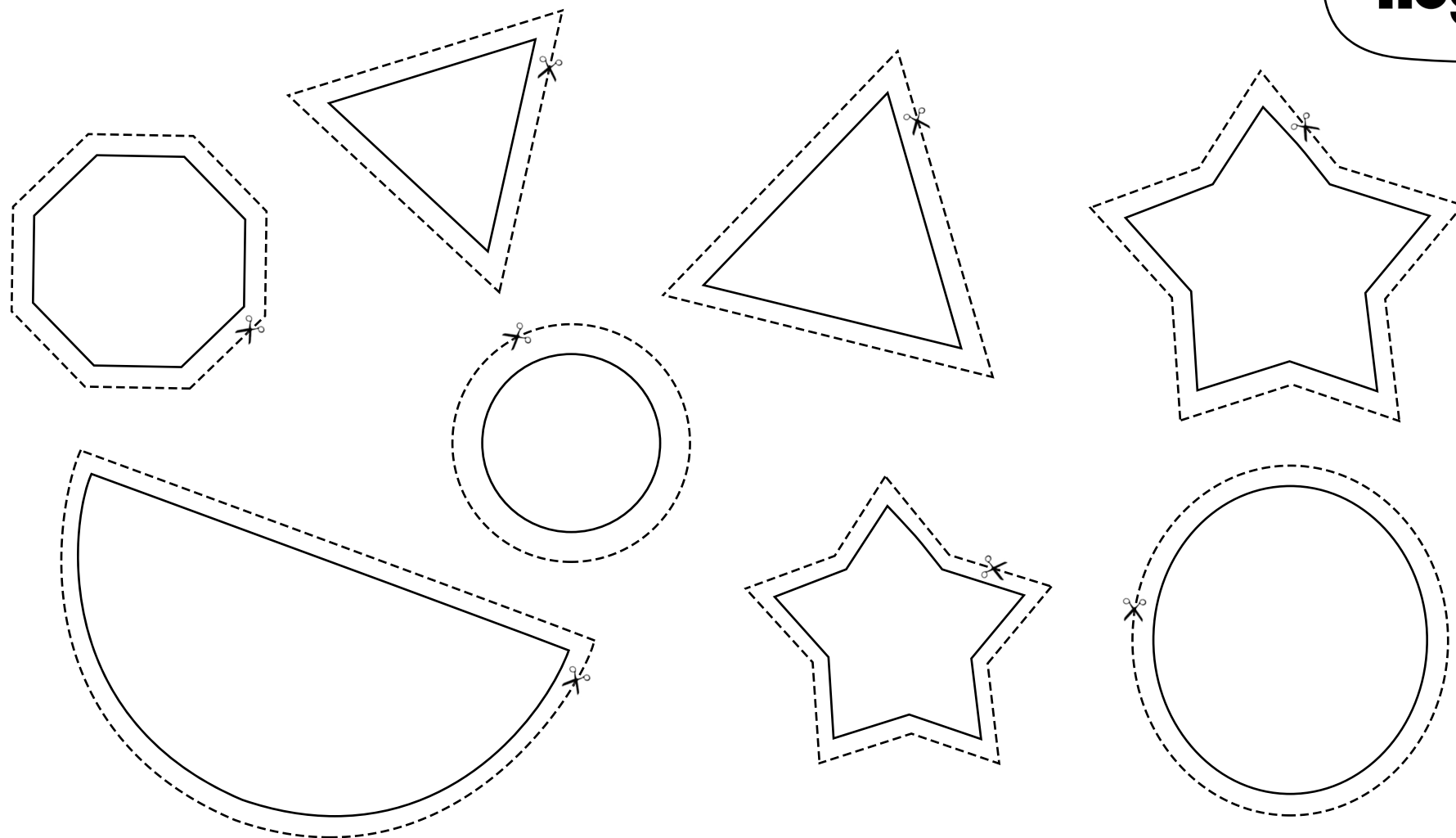
With your child, color in and cut out all the different shapes. Using the pumpkin puzzle pages from the previous pages, glue on different shapes to create their spooky – or silly – jack-o'-lantern's eyes, nose, and mouth!



**CREATE YOUR OWN**

Color in this blank pumpkin with your child, then cut out the shapes on page 6 of this activity pack. Create a spooky – or silly – jack-o’-lantern by gluing on eyes, a nose, and a mouth using different shapes!

**Learning tip:** Pick one of the pieces and ask your child if they can name something nearby that is the same shape. (For example, a stop sign is shaped like an octagon!)



## CREATE YOUR OWN - SHAPES

With your child, color in and cut out all the different shapes. Using the blank pumpkin from the previous page, glue on different shapes to create their spooky – or silly – jack-o’-lantern’s eyes, nose, and mouth!

**Learning tip:** Pick one of the pieces and ask your child if they can name something that is the same shape. (For example, a door is shaped like a rectangle!)
