






## **BLUE'S CLUES PUMPKIN PAGE**


Learning tip: When you place a new piece on the pumpkin, ask your child what the name of the shape is.


Learning tip: Every time you place a new piece on the pumpkin, ask your child how many sides the shape has.



### **CREATE YOUR OWN**


