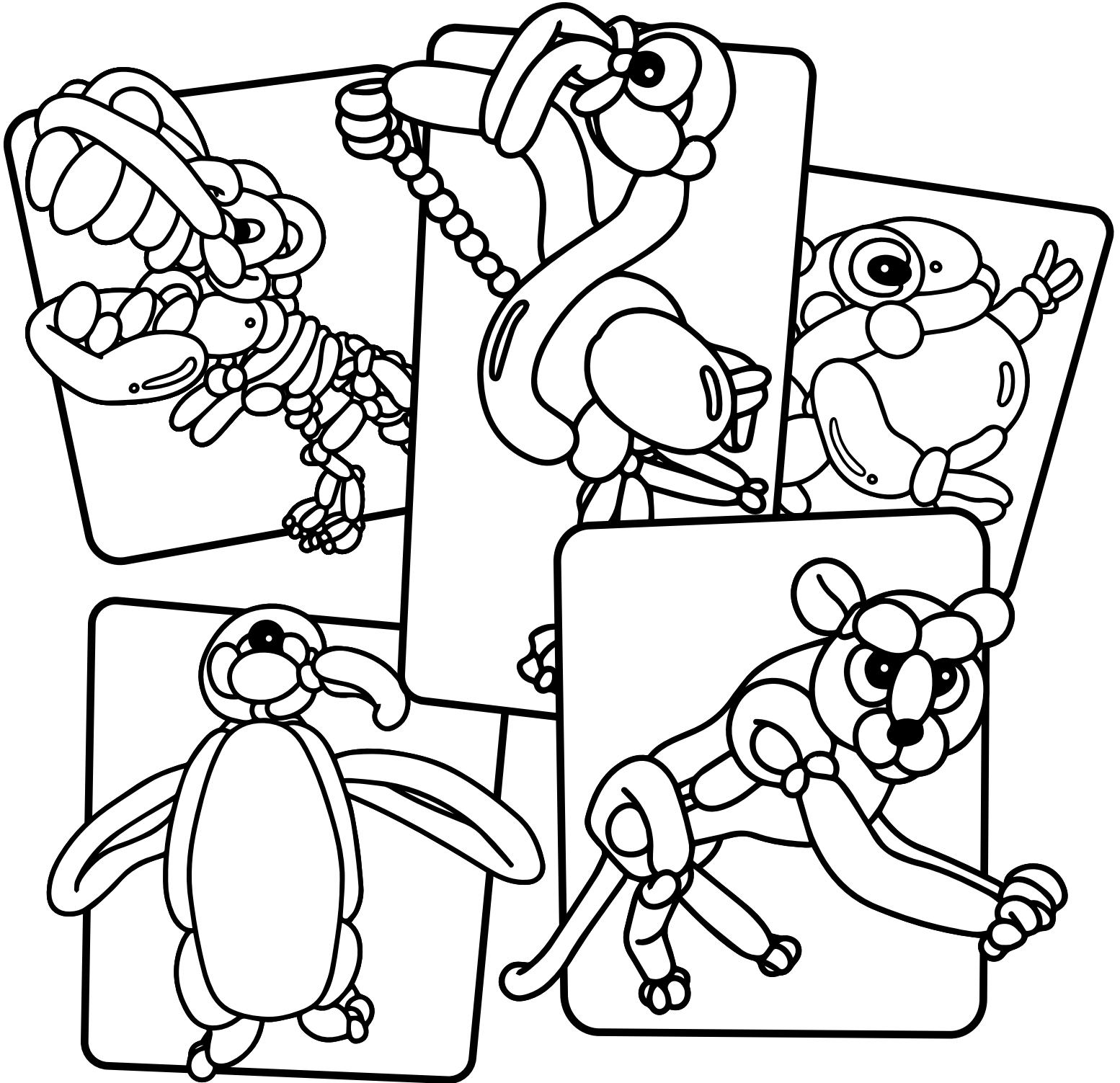


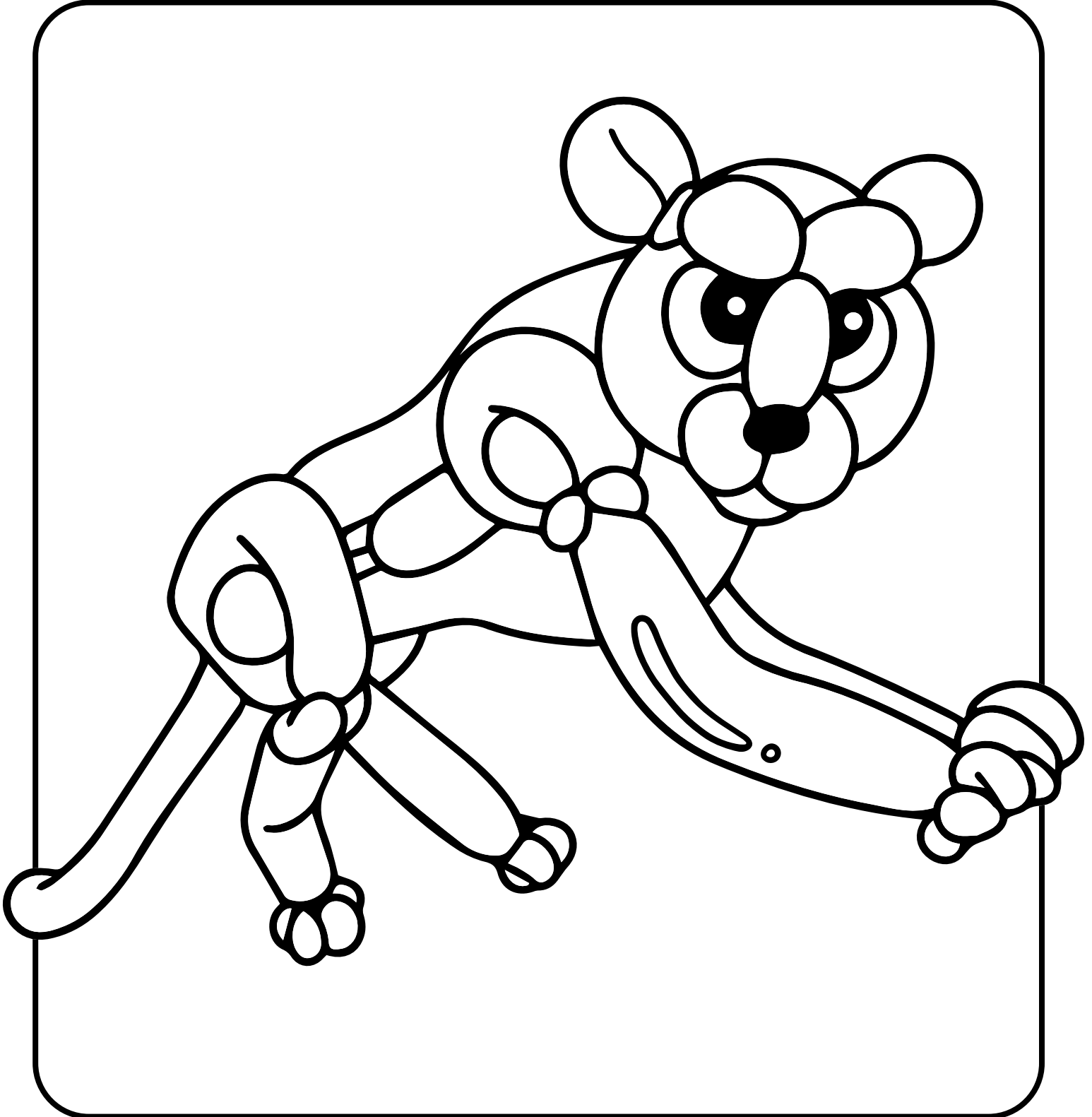
Balloon Builders

Fun Fact Coloring Pack



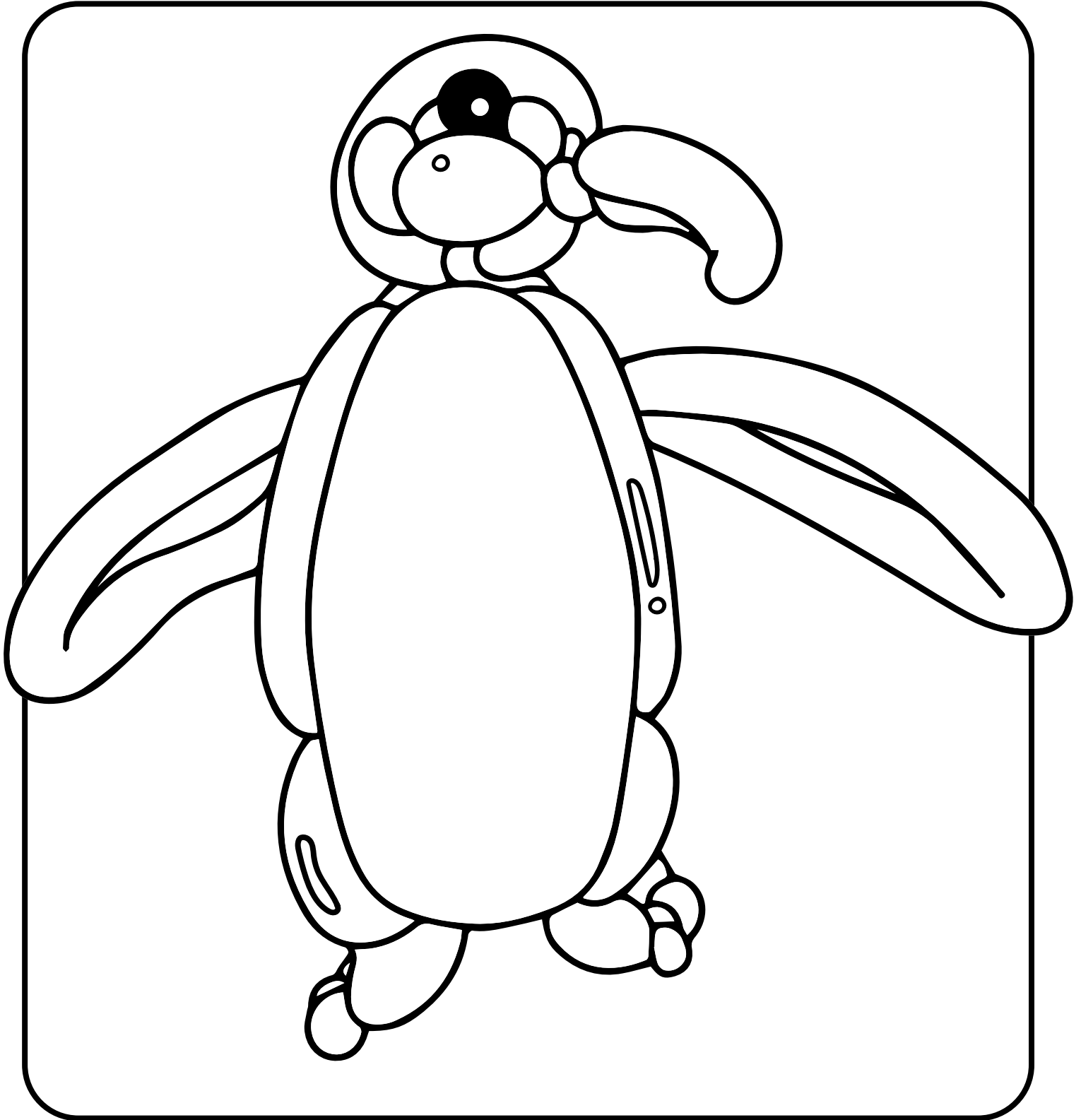

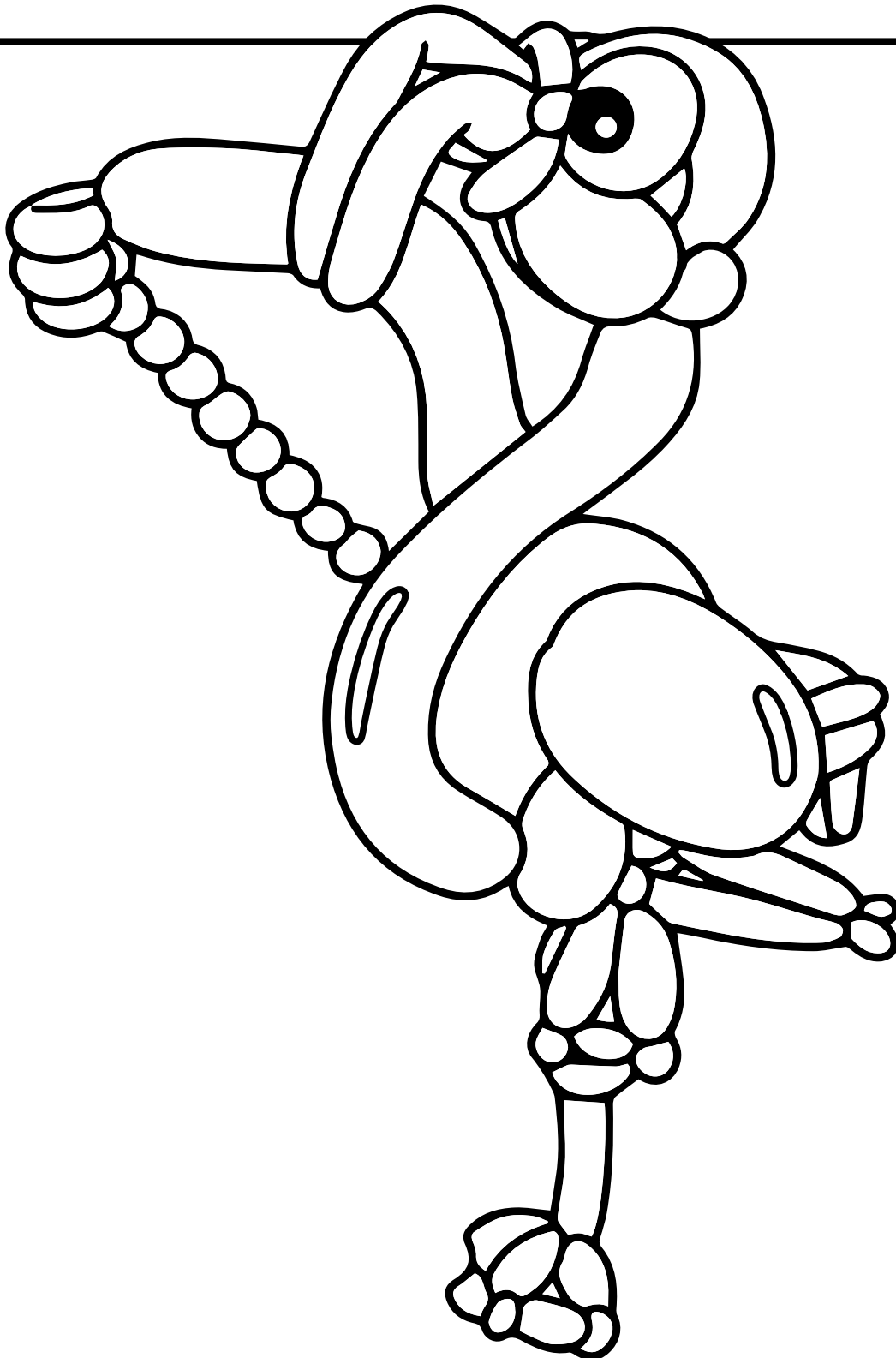

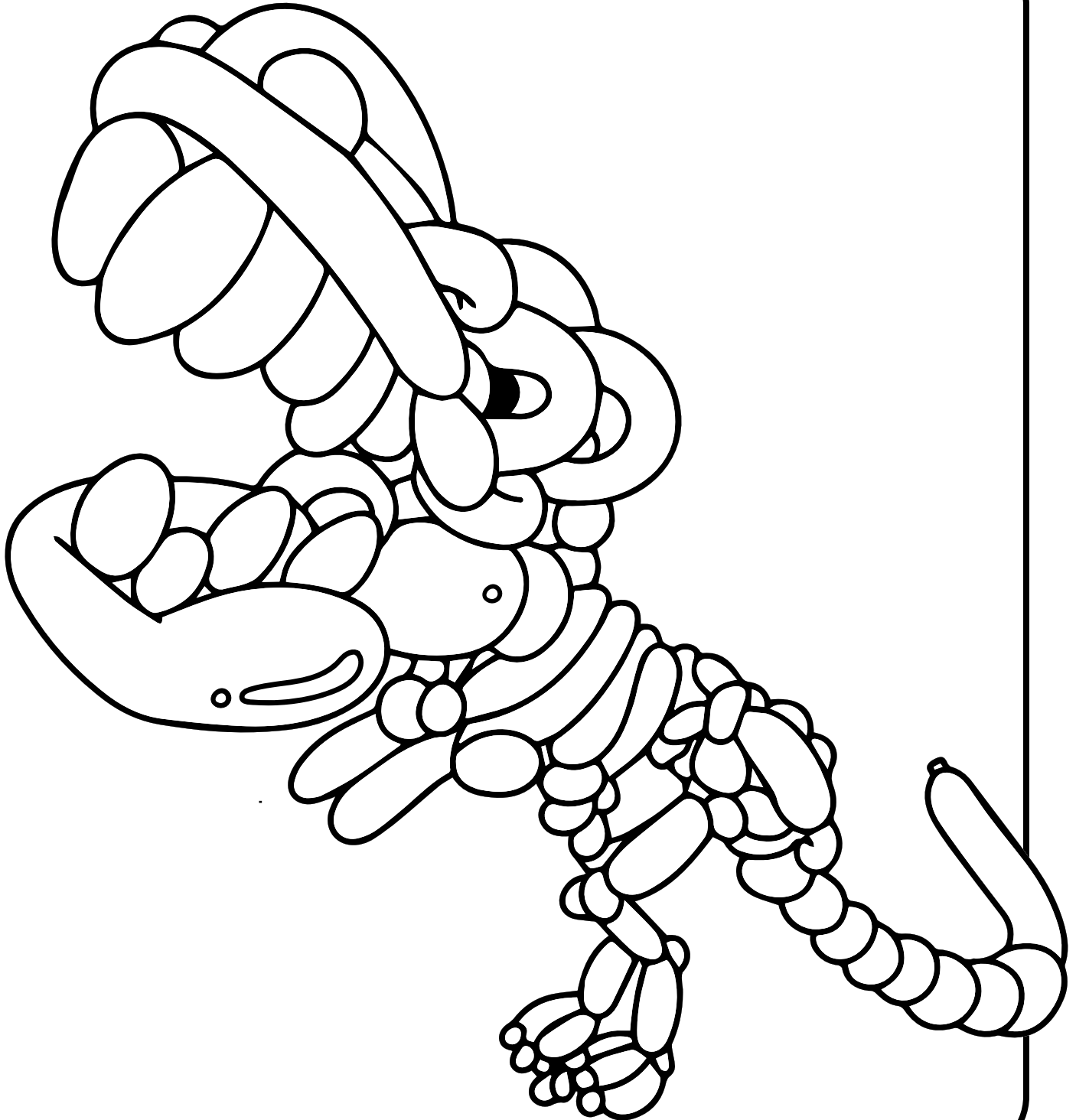
Flamingo feathers naturally grow in gray, but their feathers turn a vibrant pink from all of the algae and brine shrimp they eat.

Scientists know about dinosaurs from studying fossils, which are preserved dinosaur bones, horns, or teeth that have been turned into rocks. A **Tyrannosaurus rex (or T-Rex)** had about 50-60 teeth, each the size of a banana!

The male **American Bullfrog** bullfrogs make their croaking noise by inflating air into their mouth, just like the balloons Shana blows up!
